Organization

ROMPRO Foundation has been registered on 16 Feb 2016 as Stichting Romani pentru Romani (Rom-Pro) and is located in Amsterdam. The Foundation objectives are:

Creation of a social platform and organizing events for the Romanian Community in the Netherlands;

Perpetuating Romanian Identity, traditions, language and cultural heritage in a multicultural society;

Creation and development of a social community that is prepared to act as a safety net on diverse social aspects;

Boosting the development and social involvement of the Romanian Community in the

Members have the right to be compensated for their activity, in practice some of the costs incurred in this activity may be by mutual agreements compensated if funds are available and according to the compensation rules.

The Board meets at least twice a year, the Executive is appointed for maximum of two years and can be reelected.

The Foundation doesn't have employees but works volunteers that are involved in different projects.
